Position Summary

The Young Adult Ministry Coordinator will lead and grow a thriving ministry for adults in their twenties by cultivating spiritual growth, developing volunteer leaders, creating a welcoming community, and helping young adults take their next step in following Jesus.

Primary Responsibilities

Spiritual Leadership

- Lead a regular (weekly or bi-weekly) Bible study.
- Disciple and mentor young adults in their faith.

Leadership Development

- Recruit, equip, and encourage volunteer leaders.
- Lead regular leadership team meetings and provide ongoing coaching.

Community Building

- Plan regular social events and occasional retreats that encourage connection, outreach, and spiritual growth.
- Create welcoming environments where new people can easily belong.

Church Engagement

- Create events for this age group where they can invite friends and reach new people.
- Partner with the University Ministry for events and activities, as appropriate.
- Encourage participation in Sunday worship, life groups, volunteer teams, and the broader life of the church.
- Collaborate with church staff and ministry leaders to advance The River's mission.



Qualifications

The ideal candidate will:

- Demonstrate a growing relationship with Jesus Christ and embrace The River Church's mission.
- Have a passion for discipling young adults.
- Build relationships easily and lead with humility.
- Recruit and develop volunteers effectively.
- Possess strong communication and organizational skills. Be available for Sunday mornings, evenings, and occasional weekend events.

- Young adult, college, or church ministry leadership.
- Leading Bible studies or small groups.
- Volunteer coordination and event planning.
